- You will participate in the core team of your training. Here you discuss mainly training-related topics. (e.g.: academic calendar, professional discussions, internship assignments, curriculum changes, involvement in quality assurance within your programme (varioso),...).
- Together with student representatives from other study programmes, you sit on the campus student council. Here you build together in a nice and warm study and campus climate.

What do we offer?

- A lot of nice contacts with other student representatives from other courses and campuses,
- The opportunity to learn how to meet and collaborate with Odisee colleagues and students,
- A reimbursement of your expenses in function of your assignment as a student representative.
